SCHEDULE

ARRIVAL: After 3 pm on Friday, May 25th

PERFORMANCE: On Saturday, all classes will run in numerical order except trail.

TRAIL: Trail will open following showmanship and close at 3 pm on Saturday.

RANCH HORSE: (39-55). These classes will be going on at the same time on Sunday, with age divisions rotating from class to class. All ranch horse classes are expected to conclude by 12 Noon, but could end sooner.

GAMING: Games will begin immediately following the ranch horse classes on Sunday and run straight through until completion. Approximate start time depends completely on number of entries.

Attention NON-4-H Youth Exhibitors: If you are 9-11 years of age as of 9/1/17, you may participate in the JR classes. 12-14 years of age as of 9/1/15 may participate in the INT division and 15-19 years as of 9/1/17, may participate in the SR division. OPEN division will include anyone 9 years old (as of 9/1/17) and older who chooses to ride OPEN.

You must be 9 years of age or older as of 9/1/17 to participate.

CAMPING & STALLS

CAMPING: Campsites and Stalls are available. Call Rosie to make arrangements. 541-548-6088

RATES FOR CAMPING: Pre-registration, \$30 per night with or without electrical.
Post-registration, \$35 per night with or without electrical.

RATES FOR STALLS: Pre-registration, \$20 per stall, for the weekend.
Post-registration, \$25 per stall, for the weekend.
Bring your own bedding

GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES

HELMETS: All youth 18 & under and ALL 4-Hers, must wear approved headgear.

RULES: In all cases where appropriate, general 4-H rules apply. Contest Guide PNW 574

STALLIONS: Are NOT allowed.

CHAPS: Are allowed in Open and Trail Classes ONLY. (Not In Hand)

EXPECTED CONDUCT: This is a family event sponsored by a youth organization. Alcohol may be consumed, by those of legal age, **in private RVs or camp sites only**. The fairgrounds is a smoke-free facility, and therefore, smoking must also be contained to those areas. 4-H members, leaders, and their families are expected to follow the official 4-H code of conduct.

FINAL DECISIONS: The show committee reserves the right to make final decisions regarding rule interpretations, eligibility and schedule as they see fit.

EXHIBITORS participating in **Trail, Bareback, or Working Pairs** may ride either English or Western.

ROPING: Juniors and OPEN/beginners will be roping dummies, Intermediates will rope a "calf tracker" pulled by a 4-wheeler, Seniors and OPEN exhibitors will rope cattle in a small enclosed area. Intermediates will jerk their slack and let go of the rope, seniors and open exhibitors will demonstrate proper dally techniques. For those expecting to dally, saddle horns should be covered. All exhibitors should have some minimum roping experience BEFORE trying it at the show. **Bring your own equipment.**

COW WORKING: Exhibitors will be given a specific sorting or separating "pattern" and a specific time in which to accomplish the task(s), depending on division. All exhibitors should have some minimum cow working experience BEFORE trying it at the show.

**ALL CATTLE CLASSES
MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED.**

RANCH HORSE PATTERN: This will be a pattern designed with elements you might see in western riding as well as on a working ranch.

RANCH HORSE KNOWLEDGE: This is a class without the horse that may include knot tying, ear tagging, and question answering.

WALK-TROT: Walk/Trot classes are for riders or horses not ready for a traditional canter/lope class. NO cross-entries will be allowed. Of course, if these riders would like and are ready to do showmanship, that is certainly acceptable.

ENTRIES & AWARDS

ENTRY FEES: Pre-entry postmarked by **May 21st**.

Pre-entry Performance: Classes 1-31 \$60.00 for the day or \$12 per class

Post-entry Performance: Classes 1-31 \$70.00 for the day or \$15 per class

Pre-entry Ranch Horse & Gaming: Classes 32-71 \$60 for the day or \$12 per class

Post-entry Ranch Horse & Gaming: Classes 32-71 \$70 for the day or \$15 per class

Pre-entry for Both days: Classes 1-71 \$110 for the weekend

Post-entry for Both days: Classes 1-71 \$130 for the weekend (excludes classes 44-46,48-51)



CATTLE CLASSES ARE PRE-ENTRY ONLY!

Cross Entries - No cross entries allowed. Exhibitors may show in only one age division.

Non 4-Hers - Are Welcome! Show in the appropriate class for your age as Sep 1, 2017. (9-11, junior; 12-14, intermediate; 15-19, senior or in OPEN—your choice)

AWARDS: Awards to first - ribbons to sixth. Eligible high point exhibitors will be same horse, same rider for all classes.
