

4-H General Advisory Meeting
July 10, 2012

The meeting began at 7:17pm.

Candi Bothum presided over the meeting.

1. Record Book check list should be out by the week ending 7/13/12. This is the list of youth that have not passed Record Books and need to for Fair.
2. A reminder of Pre-Fair requirements:
 - a. 3 hours of Community Service with their club or in another service capacity.
 - b. Education requirement is needed as well.
 - c. Refer to July Over the Clover pg. 15 for complete details.
 - d. Community Service opportunities available in the coming days:
 1. Cinnamon Roll Camp, Mon. July 16th, contact Karen Moss or the Extension office, 15 volunteers needed.
 2. Packets for Horse Fair need to be put together.
 - e. A question was asked, "What requirements go across the board and what are project specific?"
 1. Community Service goes across the board for all project areas.
 2. Educational areas use the common sense rule. i.e. Going to a class on pig feed doesn't meet the Home Ec requirement.
 3. There are also advancements to pass. Horse has a different set of advancements than other project areas.
3. There is an offer to someone to fill the open Staff position. After all the paperwork is complete the new person will be announced.
4. Tractor Driver needed during Fair:
 - a. Shifts to be filled would be approximately 6-9 am and 4-7 pm.
 - b. Adult/experience needed or Youth/Tractor Safety Certified.

5. Over the Clover Café Schedule: Erin Biskup says only 7 shifts left to fill and it counts for next year's Community Service. Look for schedule in the July Over the Clover Newsletter.
6. Presentations or Demonstrations for Fair in the North Sisters building:

 - b. Anything can be presented or demonstrated
 - c. Contact Reaza or Candi
7. General questions and comments:
 - a. Please inform kids not to touch any 4-H projects in the North Sisters building.
 - b. Donations of meat are no longer taken for the Buyers BBQ. The cost is prohibitive to pay the cut fee for the meat. It has been decided that purchasing roasts are more cost effective.
 - c. Iron Chef was discussed:
 1. It will be held Wednesday evening 5pm at Fair.
 2. Teams may sign up for the event.
 3. It will be held in the North Sisters.
 - d. Outdoor cooking to be decided at a later date.
