

## Horse Advisory Meeting

March 15, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm.

There was three Spring Horse Classic items sent to a vote. The items would be paid for out of the Horse fund.

- a. Should the fees for Spring Horse Classic participants be paid, approximately \$650.00?

Vote, Yes.

- b. There was a private sponsor for \$400.00 for shirts. Put to vote was should the Horse fund be used to pay the remaining \$325.00 for the remaining cost of uniforms?

Vote, Yes.

- c. Also there has been written requests for travel scholarships for families in need. The need would be approximately \$500.00.

Vote, Yes.

June 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> is the annual DCLA Horse Show.

- a. Discussed was the need and desire for concessions. Also, who would do them and where would the funds go. The question was asked if it was permitted by the fairgrounds to actually have them. Karissa will check on the availability, she will get back to us and the decision will be made at a later date.
- b. It was asked if Christina Bates would do the volunteers for the show. Since she was not in attendance, she will be asked to take that responsibility.
- c. Flyer distributions will be sent out by e-mail when completed. It was asked if we could print and put them in our communities. Also it was suggested that it be advertised on Craig's List.

It was put to vote whether showmanship should not be included in the new Gaming High Point award.

Vote, Yes.

There was a discussion concerning the Showmanship rules at the County level. After much discussion it was decided that Karissa needed to get back with the committee on certain aspects before decisions can be made.

Precision Driving and Reinsmanship will now be offered at the County and State level.

This year Dressage at the State level will have new tests: Training Level 1,2,3 and First level 1,2,3

It was asked if there could possibly be a Walk/trot Dressage offered. Karissa will check on that.
