## General Advisory Meeting July 5, 2011

The meeting began at 6:16 p.m.

Candi Bothum began the meeting with reminders of pre-fair and fair activities.

- 1. Record Book Checks:
  - a. Community Service requirement of 3 hours
  - b. Educational Event needed i.e. Idea Fair, Clinics, HDLR, etc. Horse shows are not considered educational events.
  - c. Livestock and dog need 4 items to show progress.
  - d. All records from last year must be closed.
  - e. If previous records have been lost, destroyed, etc., you must contact Candi.
  - f. If a year is not recorded because of not participating in a 4-H club:
    - 1. Put older records and the new records together
    - 2. Or start records over again
  - g. Horse advancements need to be completed for all 4-H participants who will be riding a horse.
  - h. Ranch Horse Advancements do start at #8, but that is an error and it should be corrected in the near future.
  - i. Permanent records should be up to date, but not closed out until Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - j. Production animals need a form completed.
  - k. Individual Health records needed for each animal.
  - 1. Profit and Loss to be done on production animals.
  - m. Records should be completed on all individual projects i.e. Photography, Sheep, Home Ec, etc.
- 2. A Grievance Committee is formed to advise when there are exceptions to the rules.
  - a. A letter needs to be written to Candi Bothum concerning why an exception needs to be made i.e. animal dies, etc. All information needs to be included and a proposed solution provided. If warranted the grievance letter will be presented to the grievance committee. All decisions will be final.
  - b. Check rules in Exhibitors Handbook.
- 3. Interviews will be done Aug. 1<sup>st</sup> 9-4:30 for all High Point, Champion, Reserve Champion awards. See Exhibitors Handbook for rules.
- 4. Thank you notes reminder:
  - a. A PDF is at www.deschutes4h.com on how to properly do thank you notes.

- b. When in the ring, ribbons will be given, sponsors announced, and a card will be given to participants indicating sponsors name, address, and award.
- c. Bring completed thank you notes properly addressed, stamped, but NOT sealed to 4-H office in North Sisters during fair. These notes will be edited by Teen Staff.
- d. When finished correctly, final awards will be distributed to participants.
- 5. Awards still need sponsors. Please refer to <a href="www.deschutes4h.com">www.deschutes4h.com</a> for an updated list of awards that still need to be sponsored.
- 6. Kathy Russell spoke on Special Awards, Interviews, and Awards Ceremony.
  - a. Livestock Awards will be on Sunday Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm.
  - b. Application and record books are needed for all Special Awards. Application and rules are in the Exhibitors Handbook at www.deschutes4h.com.
  - c. Concerning club awards, make sure as many club members are present as possible to receive award.
- 7. Presentations by 4-H participants will be given in the North Sisters building during fair. Call Candi to set up a time to present.
- 8. Check out time at fair is 5:00 pm, Sunday Aug. 7<sup>th</sup>. Nothing should be removed before that time.
- 9. A reminder that proper attire should be worn when representing 4-H at the fair. No spaghetti straps, long sleeves, no flip flops, be neat and clean. No shirts with beer logos, wine logos, or marijuana leaves on them.
- 10. Buyers BBQ:
  - a. Only 4-H and FFA members to work the BBQ, no friends.
  - b. Participant sign ups with Dawna Johnston for the BBQ.
  - c. Clubs can still decorate tables at the BBQ.
