car accident on December 14, 2011. Tyler spent
all of his school years as a 4-H member raising
and showing beef cattle, among many other 4-H
projects. His daughter Calli was following in his
foot steps and started with sheep.

The Tyler VanCleave Memorial Scholarship
Foundation is put in place to provide a 4-H
Breeding Stock Beef Scholarship to a Deschutes
County 4-H member each year, beginning in
2013.

And for those who don't know, Tyler was
Ralph McNulty's grandson.

yourself and your animals.

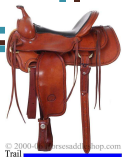
The fairgrounds is usually open around
