Deadline: March 15th, Amount: \$500.00

Requirements:

- Must be currently enrolled in Deschutes county 4-H and have been a 4-H member and a Teen Staff member for a minimum of two years; and be a current year high school graduate.
- Can win Scholarship only once.
- Transcripts are requested, but only average grades are required. Grade points are not considered a priority for this scholarship.
- Scholarship can be used at any college (community college, trade school, vocational school, 4-year college etc.)
- Scholarship will be given for the second term in college/trade school.
- Scholarship winners are expected to participate in the current year county fair to complete eligibility.

Other information:

- Two or three alternates will be chosen as there is always a chance plans will change regarding college.
- Multiple areas in 4-H will be looked at.
- All committee decisions are final.
- Finalists may be interviewed.
