Beginning in 2008, one scholarship for the full amount of the program registration will be awarded to a youth applicant from a county in Central Oregon (Crook, Deschutes, or Jefferson counties). In the event that there is no applicant from Central Oregon, the scholarship may be awarded to a quality applicant from another county.

Leyla Estes is a Crook County 4-H alumni and past participant of the Oregon Know Your State Government program. Her KYSG experience contributed to her interest in public policy and early career opportunities. She wants to share her good fortune and support Oregon youth to have this valuable experience.

Criteria

4-H members in grades 9-12 are encouraged to apply.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the quality of the essay responses.

Submit this page with appropriate signatures,

And a separate document (1-2 pages) that includes:

A) Personal data. [Your name, county, home and e-mail addresses, and phone number(s).]

B) Responses to these three essay statements.

Briefly describe your 4-H and/or community and leadership involvement.

Briefly describe your understanding of Oregon's system of government and how you think an individual citizen can influence public decision-making or Oregon law.

Briefly describe two issues facing the state of Oregon today.
